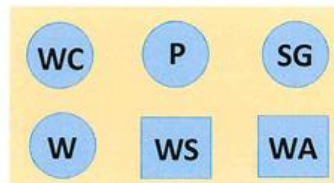

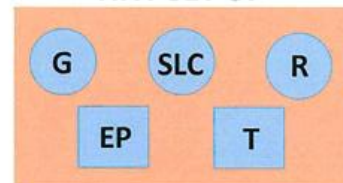

TINT SET UP

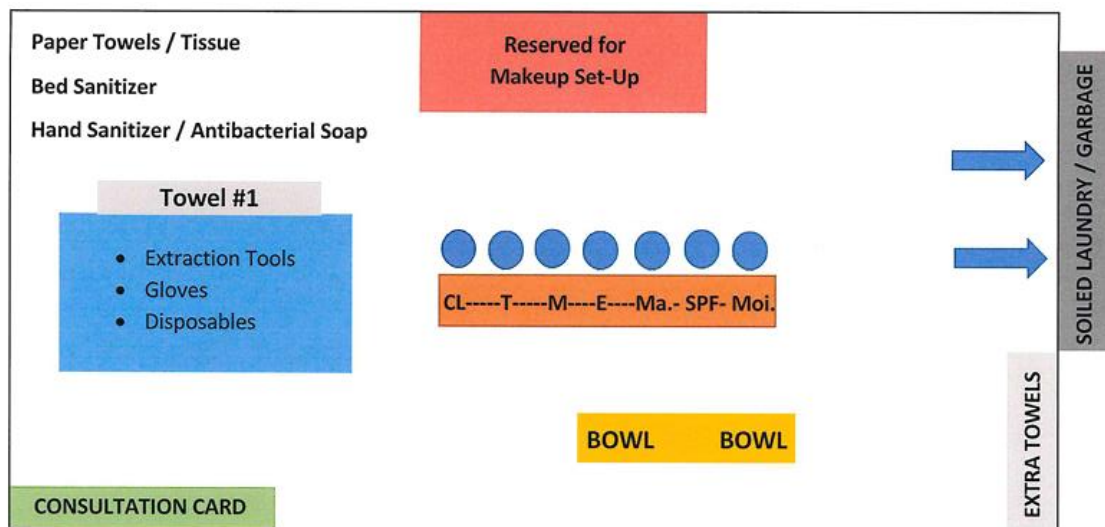

FACIAL

(20 MINUTES)

Protocol

1. Sanitize Hands
2. Cleanse & Remove
3. Analyze Skin
4. Exfoliate
5. Remove Exfoliant
6. Tone
7. Mask
8. Hand and Arm Massage
9. Sanitize Hands & Remove Mask
10. Extractions if needed (with gloves)
11. Tone
12. Moisturize
13. Protect, apply SPF
14. Sanitize Hands



BROW AND LIP WAX

(10 MINUTES)

Protocol

1. Sanitize hands
2. Analyze direction of hair growth
3. Prep skin with wax cleanse
4. Dust area with powder
5. Apply wax, discard applicator ("wax" can be cold cream, honey, or something similar)
6. Apply strip
7. Hold skin taut
8. Remove strip, discard used strip in waste
9. Apply pressure to waxed area
10. Repeat procedure on other areas to complete brow and lip
11. Remove any excess wax
12. Remove stray hairs with tweezers
13. Apply post epilation/soothing gel
14. Sanitize hands



LASH LIFT AND TINT

(30 MINUTES)

Protocol (on one eye ONLY)

1. Sanitize hands
2. Cleanse with skin/lash cleanse
3. Apply under eye pads
4. Glue eyelid pads on the lid
5. Glue lashes upward on the eyelid pad
6. Simulate application of perm
7. Process (at least 5 minutes)
8. Simulate application of fixation
9. Process (at least 5 minutes)
10. Sanitize hands
11. Simulate application of tint
12. Process tint (at least 5 minutes)
13. Remove tint
14. Remove glue from lashes and eyelid pads with remover
15. Sanitize hands



GENERAL INFORMATION

- You must have TWO forms of identification: State issued driver's license, LA Wallet, Social Security Card, or Passport

These forms of identification cannot be EXPIRED

- You must have your registration letter from LSBC
- You must be in dress code: All Black, All White, White Top/Black Bottoms, Any color shoe is permitted (closed toe-closed heel), no crop tops, halter tops, shorts, overalls, skirts unless below the knee with leggings, full coverage tops- no cleavage, attached sleeves, no underarms showing, no strapless or sleeveless tops
- You must arrive on time, 8:30am
- 9:00am is the cutoff time for entry, you will NOT be allowed to enter after 9:00am, no exceptions
- All phones and devices are not permitted inside of the testing facility; this includes digital watches, earbuds, earphones, and any other electronic devices. If you have any questions regarding this policy, please contact our testing department prior to your exam day.
- Talking amongst other testing participants is not permitted.
- You must arrive with all tools and items ready to test.
